WHAT'S HAPPENING AT THE MOMENT?



YEAR 7

Year 7 students have been strengthening their understanding of place value by working with large numbers and decimals, ordering and rounding them, and applying these skills to real-life problem-solving.



Currently, Year 8 students are extending their skills with fractions by comparing, calculating, and using them in a range of practical and mathematical contexts.



YEAR 9

This half term, the Year 9 topic is 'Equations, Inequalities & Formulae'. Students are building their algebra skills by simplifying, factorising, and rearranging expressions and equations.

YEAR 10

Year 10 students are deepening their understanding of ratio by exploring sharing in a ratio with real life contexts, combining ratios and even linking ratio to algebra!





YFAR 11

Our Year 11s have just completed their first PPEs (mock exams). Each teacher is now tailoring the lesson to focus on the specific needs of their class, based on the exam outcomes.



CELEBRATIONS

This year, MCA students have been smashing their personalised Sparx Maths homework. With 389,986 questions answered correctly and an incredible 5,237 hours of independent learning, our students are proving what Sparx research shows: those who complete homework to 100% every week make significantly faster progress in maths.


STAFF SPOTLIGHT










STUDENT SPOTLIGHT
