Applications

All Year 11 students should have begun their college applications. Its important for students to apply for multiple so that come August they have options. We recommend students applying for between at least 3-5 colleges/ sixth form.

A strong personal statement can make the difference in college admissions it's not just about grades. Encourage your child to reflect deeply, write authentically, and showcase their character, values, and growth. Your support in helping them brainstorm and revise can be invaluable.





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Post 16 Education and Skills White Paper

In October the government released guidance to school on Post 16 Education and Skills and the improvements we expect to see over time. Here is a summary for you as parents:

- Youth Guarantee: Every young person will be offered education, training, or support to get into work—no one left behind.
- Automatic college place: All 16-year-olds will have a guaranteed college place in reserve after GCSEs.
- Improved careers advice: Schools and colleges will offer better guidance and two weeks of work experience to help students explore future pathways.
- New qualifications: Clearer, high-quality vocational routes like V Levels will sit alongside A Levels and T Levels.
- Support for SEND learners: Inclusive pathways and qualifications will ensure all learners have access to meaningful opportunities.
- Lifelong Learning Entitlement: Young people will be able to access flexible, modular courses with loan support—ideal for retraining or upskilling later in life.
- Focus on high-value skills: Education will align more closely with employer needs, especially in growth sectors like digital, clean energy, and health.

Employer Encounters

Throughout a students time in MCA they will have a number of encounters with employers. This could be trips, visitors to the Academy and their lessons, events such as the careers fair and many more. We will create a lot of opportunities over the 5 years your child spends at MCA to build up students experiences to inspire and guide towards their future careers.
